Coordinator's Comments: After our meeting we will start the roadside cleanup and have some lunch. I know everyone has questions about the Lane filtering Bill SB1273 and Jeremy will explain how it works and answer any questions you may have.

Vice-Coordinator's Comments: SB1273 passed only 2 wheel motorcycles may only do Lane Filtering. Speed limit on road is 45mph or less. Road must have 2 lanes or more adjacent traffic lanes in the same direction of travel. Motorcycles can only lane filter between stopped vehicles. Motorcycle speed cannot be more than 15mph when filtering. Does not take effect until 90 days after Legislation closes.

Treasurer's Report:

There is \$4,356.97 Combined In-Chapter and Held by the State. There were \$159.32 in expenses last month and the chapter raised \$278.00 from 50/50 & Bike Night. Motion was made by Judi Miller and seconded by Darren Huntington to accept the report, which was approved.
