- 3. Legislative Director's Report Michael Infanzon He has spoken to Kirsten Synema regarding joining the Motorcycle Caucus in Washington DC. Due to COVID-19 many legislators are working from home. Several bills are coming up and Mike will be putting out calls to action when the time comes for these bills and others to be heard. Lane filtering; Kong's Law this is a statute to help all motorcyclists. It will change the wording to increase the penalty to felony for serious injury to a motorcyclist by a driver of anyother vehicle; riding unendorsed is going to be adding a penalty; anti-profiling only one city does not comply with the Memorial passed in 2020, mulling a way to impose consequences for noncompliance.
